The community of Anytown will be the major beneficiary of this grant. Our club has junior members from across a variety of suburbs and LGA's including: Mytown, 3206; Yourtown, 3207; Myland City Council; and Yourton Shire.

SECTION 3 - PROJECT DETAILS

Describe your project. What sporting uniforms does your club wish to purchase? Why do you need a grant to purchase sporting uniforms? Demonstrate how this will increase participation.

The ABC Badminton Association wishes to purchase player shirts for the juniors who represent the club at tournaments and competitive events. Two badminton shirts per player in a technical sport fabric with an embroidered or screen printed ABC Badminton logo will be purchased with the grant. Players will be responsible for providing their own similar-coloured shorts, non-marking sport shoes and warm-up gear.

A grant would be helpful in purchasing uniforms for our junior members because many of our juniors come from low-income families, often with only one income-earner. There are a number of families with two or more children participating in badminton and struggling with fees. There are also a number of juniors from new arrival and CALD communities whose parents don't/cannot work for a variety of reasons.

Competitive badminton requires a great deal of travel across country Victoria to regional competitions and to Melbourne for state-level tournaments. The transportation costs and entry fees often make competitive badminton difficult for these promising players. Having uniforms provided at no-cost is one less barrier for juniors to participate.

Having a club uniform will provide cohesion and a team attitude in our junior players and may encourage more of them to play in team competition.

Our club currently has 36 junior players who participate in tournaments and competitive badminton across a variety of age groups. This number has stayed fairly stable over the past 3 years with some players graduating out of the junior competitions and new players joining. The majority of these juniors are

from families with more than one child involved in badminton, from CALD communities or live in low socioeconomic areas.
